The New Governors. The detailed results of the elections will not be known for several days. It is not known whether a rough count is to warrant correct judgment. McKinley is elected in Ohio by a plurality conceded by Democrats to reach 10,000, and claimed by Republicans to reach 19,000.

The Legislature also appears to be Republican. The People's party cast about 12,000 votes. Hamilton County, in which McKinley is located, gave McKinley about 5,000 majority. Cleveland gave Campbell 300 majority, while Toledo went for McKinley.
