BRIEF COMPILATION OF ILLINOIS NEWS.

The Questions of Convict Labor and Country Roads—Rosa May Not Get the Money—Ex-Sheriff Higgins is Short \$1,700.

From Far and Near.

VANDALISM was visited by a hailstorm of unusual character, the stones being of large size and falling to a depth of two inches.

An examination of ex-Sheriff Higgins' books at Olney showed him to be in debt to the county in the sum of \$1,685.22. Mr. Higgins is in England.

W. L. GREVILLE, while en route from Cincinnati, O., to his home at Macomb, died from heart-disease on the train between Blue City and Vandalia.

ATTORNEY has been issued E. B. McGuire, William J. Brown and A. L. Wilson to organize the Merchants' Exchange Bank, with a capital stock of \$25,000, at Sparta.

CAPT. H. B. REED, the well-known custodian of Memorial hall, in the Illinois building, who was stricken blind with rheumatism some weeks ago, underwent an operation which was successful.

W. C. FLEMING, of Waverly, was arrested charged with arson. Some time ago the business portion of Waverly was destroyed by fire. Fleming is reported strongly toward Fleming. He was placed under \$500 bond.

The will of the late Rev. Bernard Rosmoeller, of Fayetteville, whereby he left upward of \$20,000 to Miss Rosa Loeschke, a school teacher, has been accepted by the probate court in the county in Germany. The new will is on the way here now. Its contents are unknown.

The subject of convict labor will be one of the most important to engage the attention of the next Legislature.

The adoption of the constitutional amendment in 1880, abolishing the convict system in the employment of the State's convicts, and the further fact that all existing contracts in that connection are soon to expire, will make it imperative on the General Assembly which is to be convened this year to make some disposition of the labor of the penitentiary inmates. Another subject that is likely to demand a good deal of attention from the legislators is that of an improvement in country roads.

The employment of convicts in improving the roads of the State. One proposition worthy of serious consideration is to utilize the convict labor in the manufacture of drain tile. It is claimed that the use of this tile at the disposal of a road is very superior to that of drainage purposes. It would keep the convicts busy for many years to manufacture sufficient drain tile to supply all the roads in the State. The filling of the roads would undoubtedly improve the condition of the roads, render them more susceptible of improvement. After an effective drainage system had been established the grading could be done with whatever material is most convenient. The friends of the convict labor for better conditions can do more effective work than by pushing that movement prominently to the front and compelling its consideration by the Legislature, which will be called on to settle the convict labor question.

The statistical report of coal production in Illinois for the year ending with June, 1891, was 321,860 tons of "lump" greater than that of any preceding similar period. The average value at the mines is substantially the same as for 1889-90. The following are the principal statistics stated in the report for last year: Counties in which coal is mined, 57; number of mines and openings of all kinds, 918; tons of all grades mined, 15,650,938; tons of lump coal mined, 12,960,242; tons worked out of 3,800 employes of all kinds, 32,951; number of miners, 29,059; boys over 14 years of age, 995; average number of days of active operation, 215.4; home value of product, \$14,237,074; average value per ton of lump coal at the mine, 92 cents; average value of other grades, 50.43 cents; average per ton paid for hand mining, 70.72527; tons of lump coal mined by hand, 9,961,159; tons mined by hand and paid for by the day, 1,216,258; number of mining machines, 242; tons of coal mined by them, 3,927,305; cubic feet of powder used, 261,392; number of men killed, 69; wives made widows, 37; children made fatherless, 112; men injured so much as to lose their lives, 24; number of men injured in life lost, 261,911; number of employes for each life lost, 549; new mines opened and old ones reopened, 91; mines closed or abandoned, 104. The report contains a valuable table showing the following items: The number of coal mines in several mines in the State: Thermal units of heating power, 11,272 to 13,668; volatile matter, 30.35 to 47.7 per cent.; fixed carbon, 45.95 to 55.5 per cent.; ash, 3.65 to 14.71 per cent.; and moisture, 3.9 to 11.85 per cent.

The creditors of the Lankrupt firm of Keener & Pike, Jacksonville, were practically left out in the cold by Keener's father entering a claim of \$77,000 against the assets.

M. MARSHALL FIELD has given \$100,000 to the University of Chicago on condition that a million, Mr. S. A. Kent's \$150,000 allowed for, be raised within ninety days.

JERSEY COUNTY delegates to the State Democratic Convention were the national and Palmer for President and Altgeld for Governor. A resolution asking the repeal of the compulsory school law was passed as far as it relates to compelling children to attend special schools.

Two men were crossing a high trestle on the Illinois central, south of Chicago, when they were overtaken by a freight train. One succeeded in making his way over in safety, but the other, an old man, 70 years of age, was too infirm to run and lay the train over him. The engine caught him and he was thrown into a slough and drowned. The man had been a prosperous baker at New Orleans. He had been married by the recent great fire, and becoming discouraged he walked out of the city, a tramp in his old age, to meet a tragic death.

German Whisky Drinkers.

Emperor William's bill for the repression of drunkenness has been revised and clipped pretty carefully by the federal council. The bill, which was passed weeks has been laid before the reichstag. Its specific aims are to discourage "drunkenness, immorality and theft" in the small whisky saloons frequented by the poorer classes.

After the enumeration of conditions which will prevent the granting of licenses in specified places and to men of a certain character the bill's ironclad provisions for the control of the retail trade in whisky, brandy, etc., are stated. These strong prohibitory liquors may not be sold in less than half-pint quantities or in rooms occupied for other mercantile purposes. Every landlord shall be arrested as soon as he is discovered not to have taken all possible steps to keep his place clear of drunkards, thieves and quiet onlookers.

In case a man gets drunk in a saloon he may be ejected only when the landlord has arranged to have him taken to his club or by a specially employed officer. The expenses of getting a drunken man home from the saloon to his lodgings are to be paid eventually by the man himself. All drinks must be paid for before the drinker leaves the saloon. The local authorities may forbid the opening of saloons between midnight and 8 a. m., and may prohibit the employment of waitresses wherever strong spirituous liquors are sold. All these provisions and about ten or twelve more are to be enforced with the aid of ten paragraphs full of penalties.

Most Germans are happy, doubtless, that two or three stringent paragraphs in the law are "not to be applied to pleasure excursions," etc.—an eminently wise exception for a country where, as Schopenhauer said, "every picnic is a roundabout way into a saloon."
