County Superintendent's Notice. Examinations for second grade certificates will be held in my office on the third Friday and Saturday of each month except July.

For a first grade certificate, the candidate must be qualified in all that is required for the second grade and in addition must pass an elementary examination in the philosophy, zoology and botany.

Estimated in per cent the required average for the second grade will be with a minimum of 70; for the first grade 90 with a minimum of 75. Satisfactory evidence of a knowledge of methods of work will be required before a second grade certificate is issued, and conclusive evidence of the work necessary in the work outlines for this county must be given before a second certificate of any grade will be granted. A fee of one dollar will be charged for each examination.
