UPROAR IN THE HOUSE. ANGRY WORDS AND SCURRILOUS OBSERVATIONS USED. Excitement Caused by a Sharp Exchange of Words Between Congressman Fithian and Morse—Arrest of a Crank in the White House.

Washington special. The House passed at the opening of the session of the House this morning between Mr. Morse, of Massachusetts, and Mr. Fithian, of Illinois, but no blows were struck and no blood was spilled.

The altercation was a cutthroat of Mr. Morse's filibustering course. Mr. Morse, in a five-minute speech this morning, tried to justify his action, during the course of which he charged Mr. Fithian with being solely responsible for the refusal of the House to permit him to print in the Record some newspaper extracts attacking Commissioner Lochren.

In a minute the House was in an uproar. The Speaker quelled the impending riot by pounding his desk vigorously with the gavel and declaring both gentlemen out of order. This closed the incident.
