

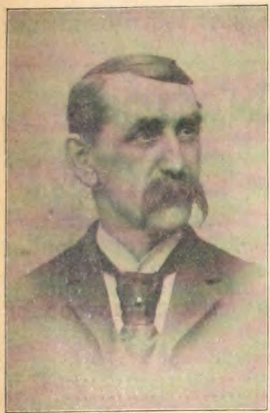
THE KEELEY LEAGUE.

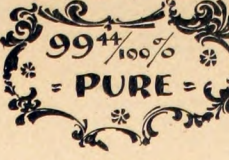
