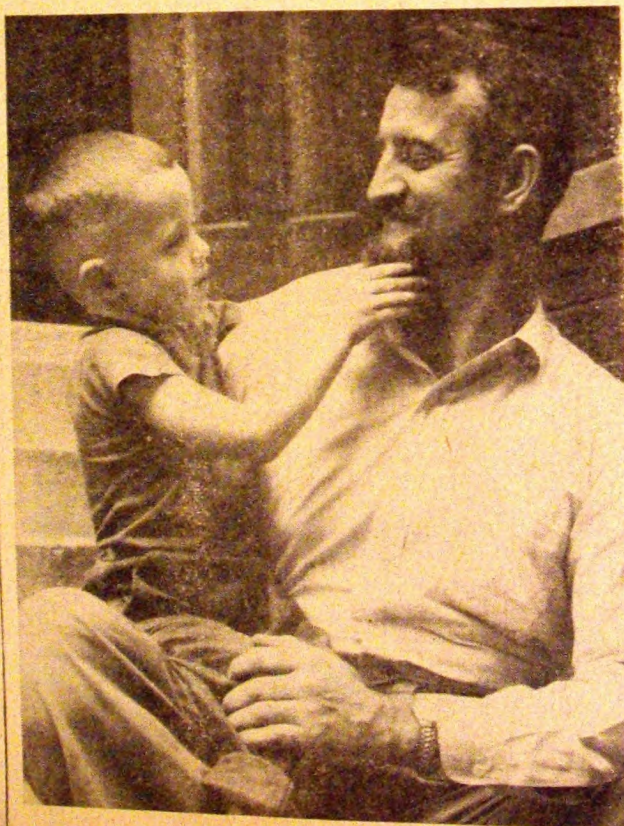
Dwight Centennial Features Kiddie Parade Tonight

Costume classifications include comic, personality, historical, originality, beauty and Mother Goose characterizations.

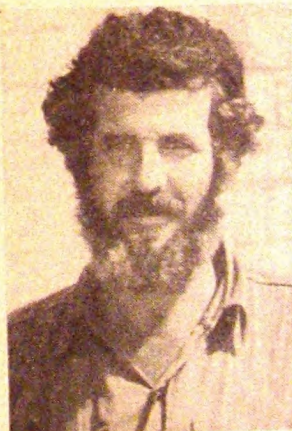


STANLEY MICHAELS, 3½, gets the feel of the Dwight centennial celebration spirit as the fingers the facial growth on his father, Floyd Michaels.
