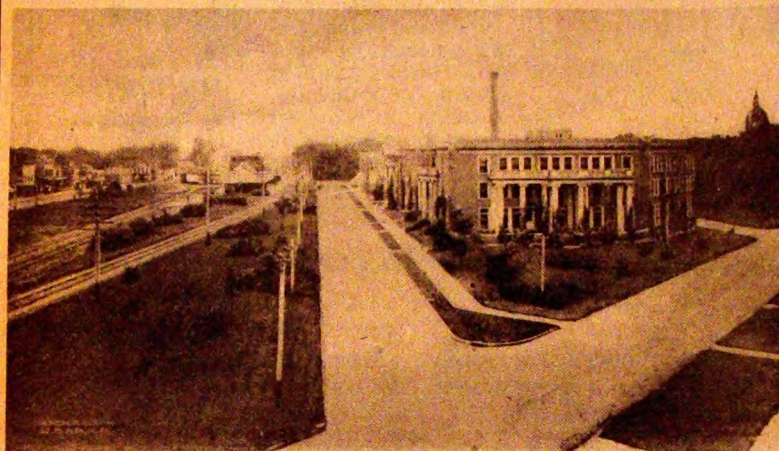

MAZON AVENUE AND WEST STREET, DWIGHT, ILL.

LOOKING BACK at Dwight history this week, we find two views of the intersection of West [Main] Street and Mazon Avenue. The top postcard shows the view down West Main Street, including the railroad station and the old "Streator Branch" on the west side of the depot. Below is a view of the "Kepplinger Block" of East Mazon Ave., which twice caught fire — and was destroyed in the second fire about 1922.
