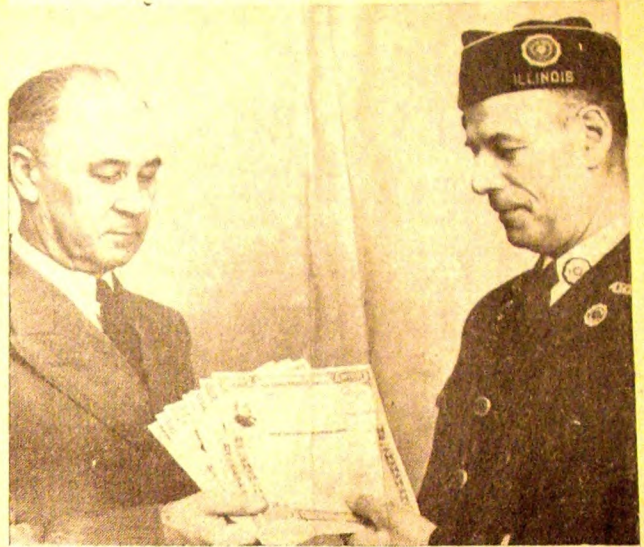


## High School Band to Play Here Sunday

## Legion Buys \$700 Worth of Defense Bonds



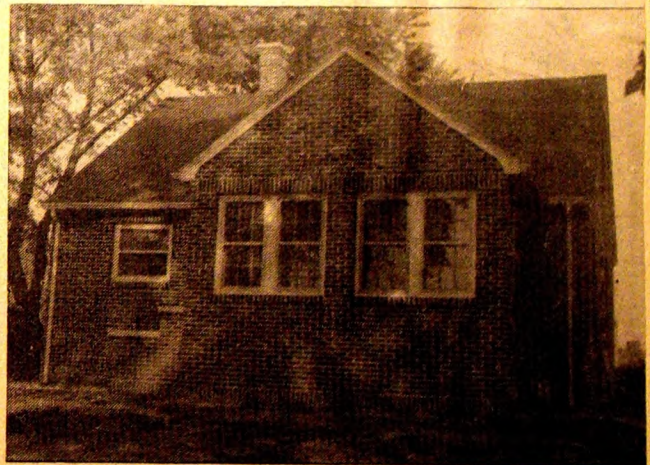
