

JUDGE CLYDE H. THOMPSON DIES OF HEART ATTACK IN CHICAGO ON TUESDAY



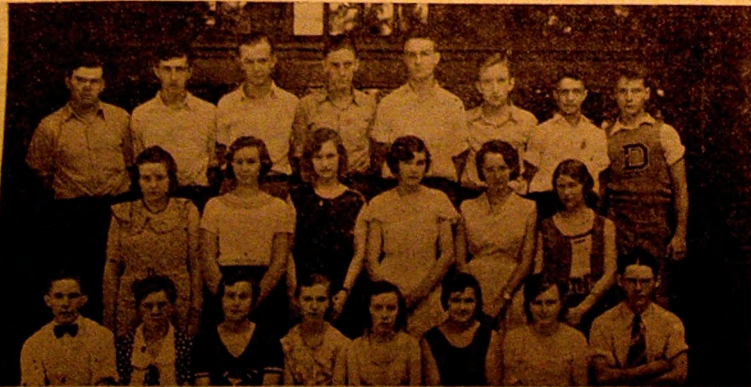
