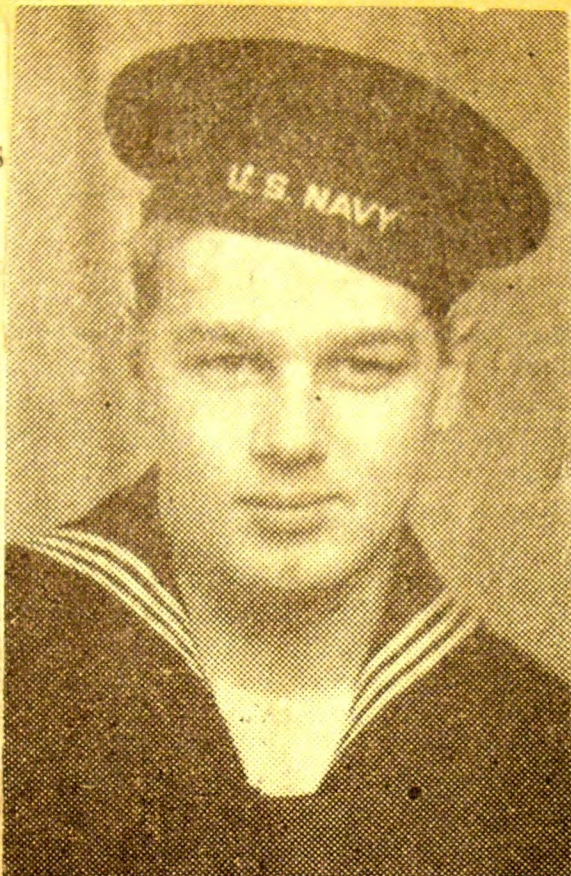


**Dr. Edw. F. Joss Leaves

In U. S. Medical Corps**



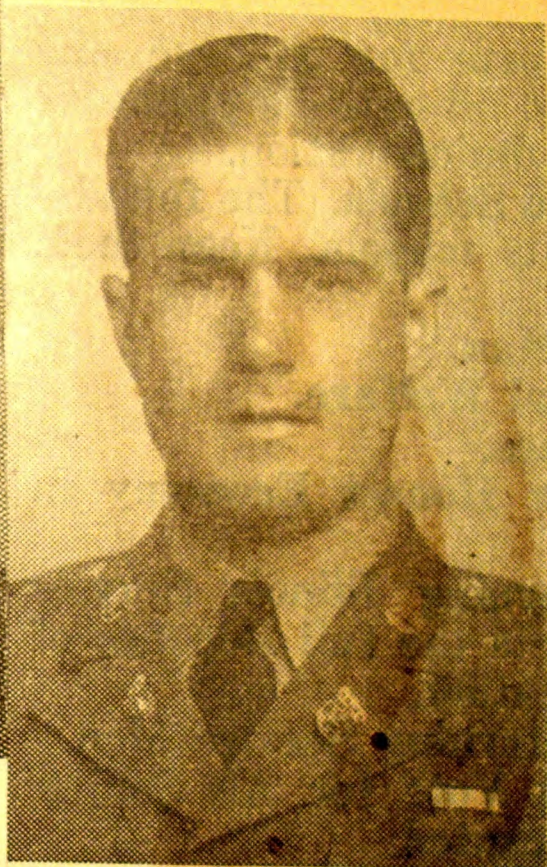
**DR. EDW. F. JOSS**
