## Tree Planted Prince On Oct

This famous tree, which stands in the corner of the lot owned by John R. Oughton, was planted by the late John R. Oughton in 1860, who afterwards became King Edward VII.

The tree-planting of the Prince, the late John R. Oughton, was on a holiday, while making a tour of duty, and the United States was on a five-day stop over from Oct. 22-26, 1860.

The tree, planted by the Oughton family, was sapling when it was cut into the heavy branches.

The Prince was a tree on the east of Dwight
