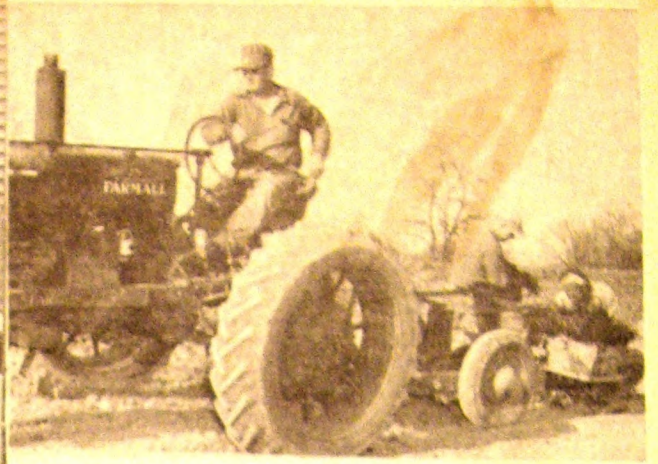

Tree Planting Project Underway at Drew Farm &



Tree planting on the Mrs. Anna Drew farm, Highland township, which is operated by Wayne Roost, Goodfarm township. The State Department of Conservation in co-operation with the Grundy County Soil Conservation District, planted on the district co-operators farm, 1000 red cedar, 6000 Jack, Scotch, and red pines. The complete tree planting was included by a planting of the new living fence, "Multiflora Rose."
Dennis Manning, Chairman of the Grundy District, stated that approximately 34 acres of tree planting have been completed in the county this spring.
This is one phase of the wildlife restoration and proper land use programs of both conservation departments. Land unsuited for cultivation when properly used, will contribute to farm income and provide recreation for the family.
