Delaware, Dwight, was graduated Friday, Dec. 12, from the United States Air Force Officer Candidate School, Lackland Air Force base, San Antonio, Texas. The December 12 graduation of 500 men and women officers was the largest in Air Force OCS history.

Principal speaker at the ceremonies was Lt. Gen Robert W. Harper, commanding general, Air Training Command, Brig. Gen. Wycliffe E. Steele, the OCS commandant, presented diplomas. Awards to outstanding graduates of the class, 52, were presented by Lt. Col. Hugh Young, assistant commandant.

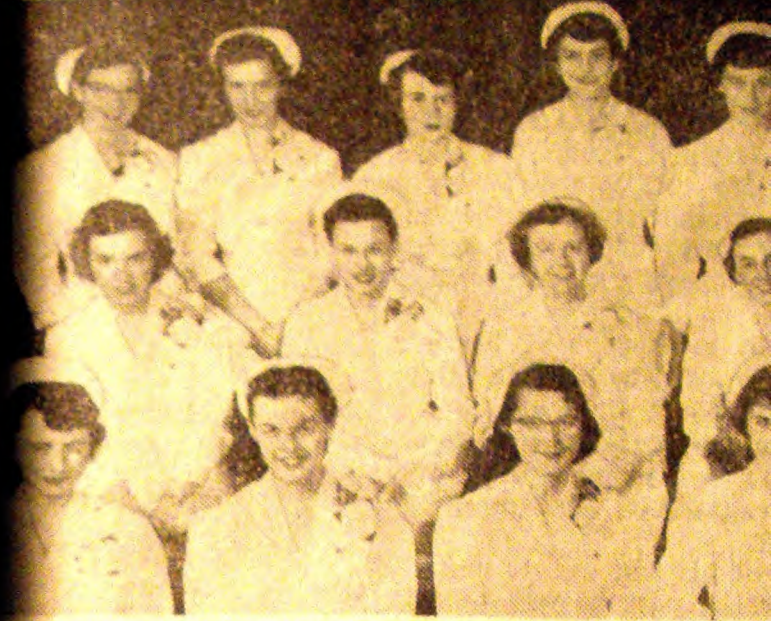
Most of the new lieutenants received 15 day leaves to spend with families and friends before commencing extended active duty assignments at Air Force bases throughout the nation.

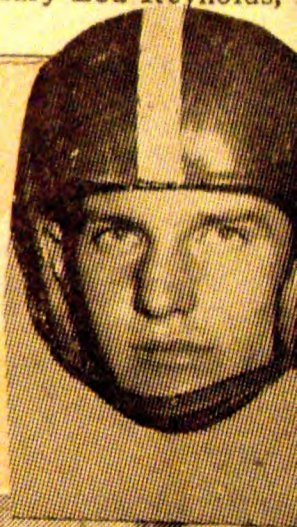
