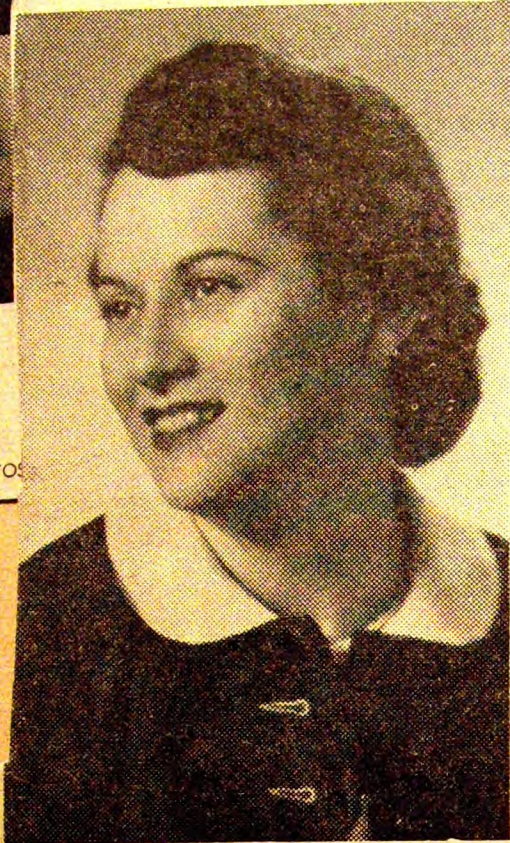


Lorraine Haag, Former Dwightite, Engaged To Aviation Cadet



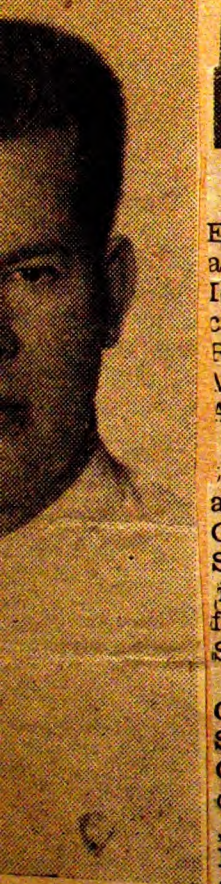

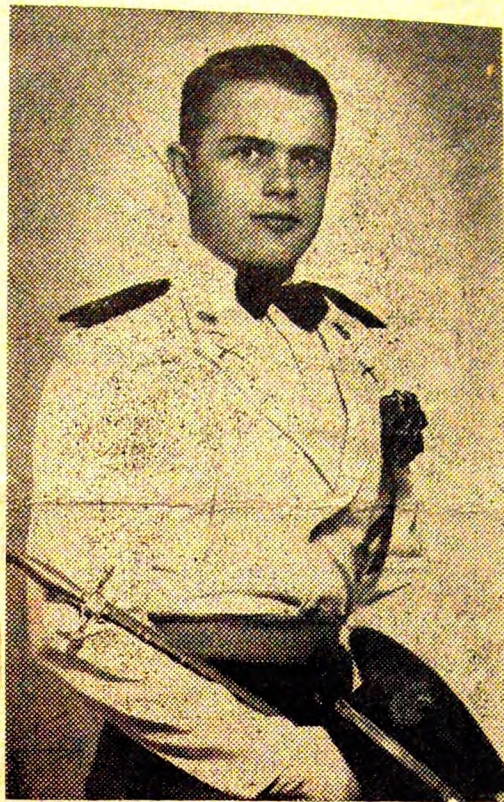
