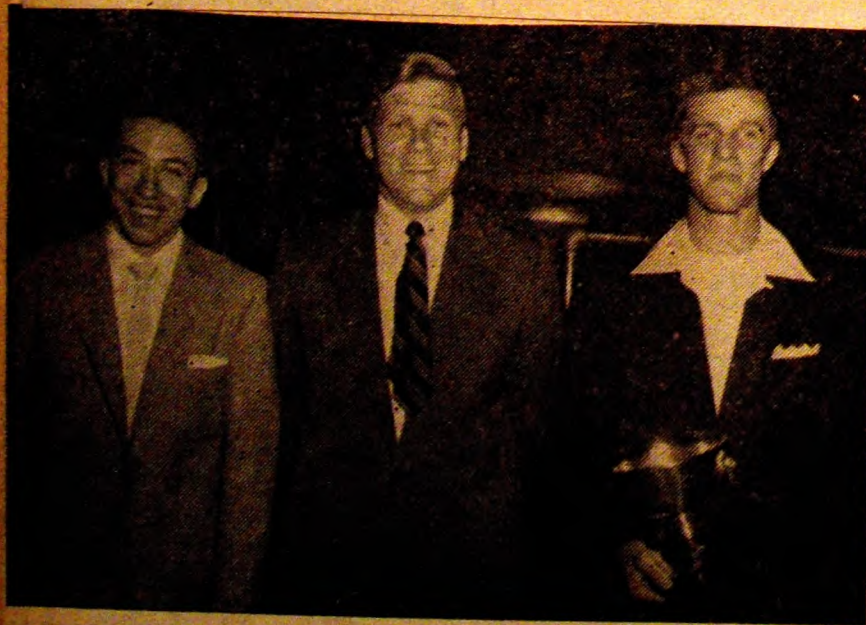

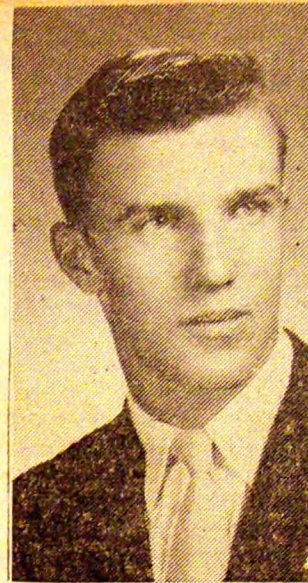
**TWO OUTSTANDING ATHLETES** of Dwight Township High school

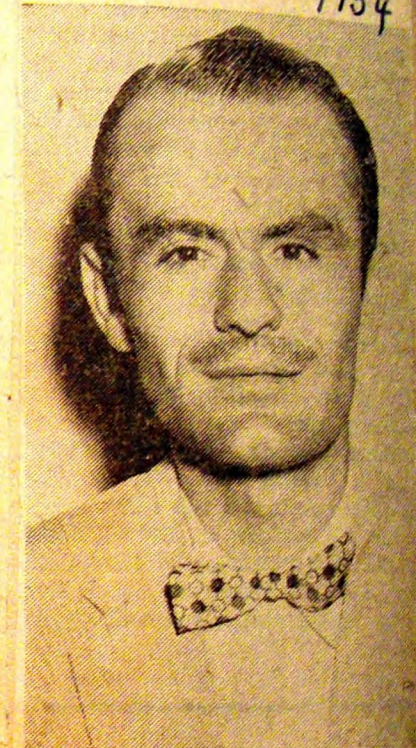
