LAND SALE.—Mr. Leander Morgan, sold his farm 1 1-2 mile North East of Dwight to Maj. Paul, for \$60 per acre.

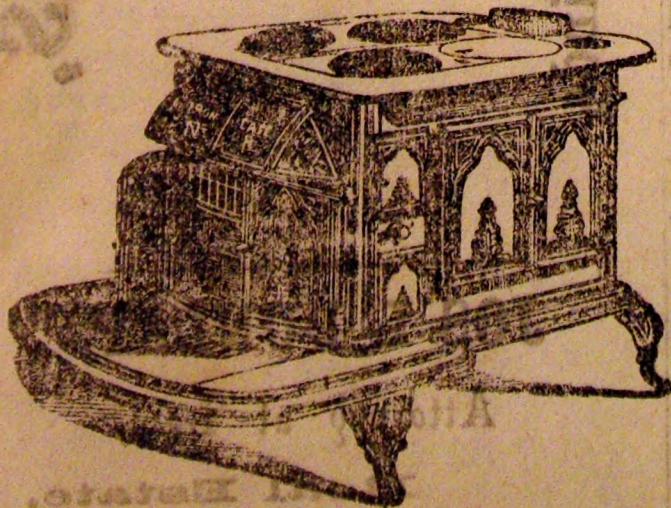

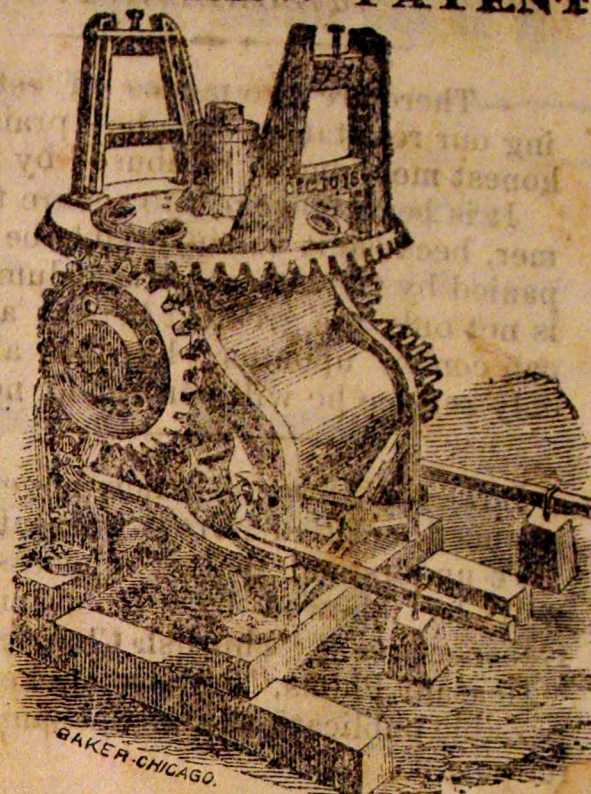
IRON GATE SMOKE BURNER!
